This offer is conditional on you achieving a minimum overall result of 80% in your bachelor degree and on meeting the English language requirement of an overall 6.0 IELTS with a minimum of 6.0 in each individual section (or TOEFL equivalent).

Please note the following:

- Tuition Fee:** The tuition fee for the MSc in Bioinformatics with Computational Biology for the 2015/2016 academic year is €14000. An initial deposit of €1000 is required to secure your place on this programme. The deposit must be paid within four weeks from the date of this letter. This deposit will be deducted from the tuition fee. The balance of the tuition fee must be paid in full no later than 1st August 2015.
- Method of Deposit and Tuition Fee Payment:** Payment should be made through our online payment system "Pay to Study" by logging on to: <https://ucc.studentfees.ie/> and quoting your UCC student number (115196121).
- Refund of Fees:**
 - if you are refused a student visa your tuition fees will be refunded in full.
 - if you do not meet the conditions of the offer your tuition fees will be refunded in full.
- Registration and Orientation:** Registration and Orientation will take place the week commencing 31st August, 2015. Details of Registration and Orientation will be relayed to you by email in early August, 2015. You are required to bring all original documents requested for admission (Academic Transcripts, Graduate Certificate, etc.) to registration.
- Term Dates:** The academic year will commence on Monday 1st September, 2015.
- Cost of Living:** As a guideline, we estimate that a student will need a minimum of €10,000-€12,000 per annum for living expenses.
